### **Principles 2018/197**

- ◆ We aim to ensure that all pupils make good progress
- ◆ Appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs for socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed
- ◆ In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognize that not all pupils who received PPG will be socially disadvantaged
- ◆ We also recognize that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for PPG
- ◆ Pupil Premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups or individuals. Limited funding and resources means that not all children receiving PPG will be in receipt of Pupil Premium interventions at one time.

### **Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2018/19**

- ◆ To improve reading, writing and maths.
- ◆ To develop writing skills through computing.
- ◆ Improve standards through high quality interventions.
- ◆ Diminish the difference in terms of PPG / Non PPG pupils in respect of progress and attainment.

### **Pastoral and Wellbeing focus of PPG spending 2018/19**

- ◆ Support for children and families
- ◆ Targeted individualised support from internal and external agencies for pupils in need of speech and language intervention
- ◆ High level support for pupils from Educational Psychologist involving investigation into behavior, speaking concentration, organization, cohesion of movement and memory etc
- ◆ Provision of OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) programme as a means to enhancing pupils' opportunity to play
- ◆ Continued enrichment to support children's social and emotional development by providing or subsidising activities such as residential trips, theatre visits etc
