Dear Parent/ Carer,

Class 3G Bubble Closure

I am writing to inform you that a pupil in the 3G bubble has tested positive for coronavirus. In line with advice from Public Health England, the 3G bubble will now close for a deep clean.

Whilst I understand that you may have concerns with regards to the above, I can assure you that the school will continue with social distancing measures and cleaning and hygiene arrangements will remain in place throughout the day.

Your child however, has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for the virus and in line with government guidance, we are asking that you keep your child at home to self-isolate for 14 days and follow the guidance below.

If you or your child begin to show the above symptoms you must follow the national guidance. For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness. However, if you develop symptoms you must self-isolate at home and arrange to have a test to see if you have COVID-19 – visit [NHS.UK](#) to arrange or contact NHS 119 via telephone if you do not have internet access.

Please inform the school of any positive results.

The isolation period is calculated from the day of positive test result as the pupil did not display any symptoms. Pupils are therefore required to self-isolate up to and including the 23rd December. If pupils are symptom free they should return to school on Monday 4th January. Staff will be in touch with you to share remote learning arrangements.
