Dear Parent/ Carer,

4P Bubble Closure

I am writing to inform you that a member of the 4P bubble has tested positive for coronavirus. In line with advice from Public Health England, the 4P bubble will now close for a deep clean.

Whilst I understand that you may have concerns with regards to the above, I can assure you that the school will continue with social distancing measures and cleaning and hygiene arrangements will remain in place throughout the day.

Your child however, has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for the virus and in line with government guidance, we are asking that you keep your child at home to self-isolate for 10 days and follow the guidance below.

If you or your child begin to show the above symptoms you must follow the national guidance. For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness. However, if you develop symptoms you must self-isolate at home and arrange to have a test to see if you have COVID-19 – visit [NHS.UK](#) to arrange or contact NHS 119 via telephone if you do not have internet access.

Please inform the school of any positive results.

The isolation period begins from the day of last contact with the positive case, which was Friday 14th May. If pupils are symptom free then their isolation period ends at midnight on 24th May. The 4P teachers will be in touch with you to share remote learning arrangements.
